





## GOALS, PROJECTS, INITIATIVES

### *1. Promote College of Dentistry as an internationally acclaimed College by continuously enhancing academic programs that produce competent oral health care professionals.*

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Stride towards excellence in teaching through regular evaluations of effectiveness, continuous faculty development, appropriate use of technology, and consistency of terms and tools across the curriculum.
  - a.1 Implement a curriculum monitoring with subject mapping and create and merge initiatives for advanced dental digital technologies.
  - a.2 Alignment of the course learning outcomes with the program learning outcomes and assessment methods.
  - a.3 Utilize student and faculty course surveys together with peer assessment of content, for continuous improvement of courses and teaching, as well as faculty professional development.
  - a.4 Establish an enhanced role for students in the curriculum.
  - a.5 Incorporate more course content of community service in the curriculum.
- b. Prepare graduates with the knowledge and skills for a rapidly evolving health care system within the approved attributes and values of the College and the community.
  - b.1 Establish a Continuing Educational Unit to conduct workshops to train the students and dentists to utilize new technologies in clinical practice.
  - b.2 Engage students in decision-making and leadership roles in College Committees.
  - b.3 Plan for annual career counseling for students and interns thru various webinar sessions.
  - b.4 Incorporate more Course Learning Outcomes that address private management and business principles.
- c. Foster a College-wide climate of professional development that values teaching and instructional best practices.
  - c.1 Create Faculty Development Unit to initiate a system for focused professional development of the faculty staff.
  - c.2 Utilize available web-based technology for faculty development e.g. webinar, etc.
  - c.3 Attract high-caliber College of Dentistry graduates to be a future faculty in the College of Dentistry.
- d. Increase national and international competitiveness of pre-doctoral program and its graduates.

## ***2. Aspire to be recognized as the National Oral Health Research Center.***

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Establish a Research Board Committee.
  - a.1 Restructure the Research Committee into a Research Board.
- b. Encourage all College of Dentistry Members to participate in Oral Health Research.
  - b.1 Establish minimum standards on publication of papers to annual portfolio of faculty members.
  - b.2 Establish performance based incentive for research activities.
  - b.3 Identify research mentors that can develop research teams of faculty members and students.
  - b.4 Utilize existing institute resources and courses to improve productivity of research projects among College of Dentistry staffs and students.
  - b.5 Collaborate with KAIMRC to develop a research summer school for College of Dentistry students.
  - b.6 Utilize research courses in the curriculum to increase the level of participation of students and faculty in research projects.
- c. Develop a research initiatives within College of Dentistry that are aligned with KAIMRC and King Abdulaziz City of Science & Technology (KACST).
  - c.1 Review initiatives of KAIMRC and KACST.
  - c.2 Align College of Dentistry research teams with KAIMRC research teams and with KAIMRC research teams.
  - c.3 Adopt KAIMRC guidelines and policies into College of Dentistry research activities.
- d. Facilitate research conduction by faculty and students.
  - d.1 Prepare database of available research resources and opportunities for faculty, staff, students, and interns.
  - d.2 Recruit active researchers through visiting professor program to encourage research within the college..

### ***3. Improve the oral health of the community through community services programs.***

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Provide outstanding community services and inspire civic engagement.
  - a.1 Promote the oral health of our local community and raise the visibility of the College of Dentistry by expanding the number of oral health outreach programs.
  - a.2 Integrate a minimum of 20 hours community service to the 4 years of the DMD curriculum.
  - a.3 Utilize the Mobile Dental Units of the MNG-HA in collaboration with KADC to increase access to care.
  - a.4 Create a website for oral health care awareness, education and prevention of dental diseases that is accessible to the public.
- b. Develop global partnerships to improve oral health.
  - b.1 Engage and participate in the global health initiatives and other collaborative opportunities.
  - b.2 Promote oral health care in collaboration with national private and public stakeholders to enhance community health.
  - b.3 Benchmark with a well-recognized international institute.
  - b.4 Utilize the visiting professor program to collaborate with high caliber professors and programs.

**4. *Create a patient-centered clinical practice that enhances the experience of the patient, student, faculty, and staff.***

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Provide patient-centered care using quality assurance measurements.
  - a.1 Encourage distinguished staff to obtain part-time M.S. degree on Quality.
  - a.2 Develop Clinical Quality Unit.
  - a.3 Benchmark clinical policies and procedures with JCIA, OSHA, and CBAHI standards.

**5. *Enhance the internal quality assurance system in the College to ensure the sustainability of quality assurance processes and achieve the requirements of accreditation in a timely manner.***

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Focus the efforts to prepare the College to obtain national and international accreditation.
  - a.1 Establish a functioning Internal Quality Assurance System within the College.
  - a.2 Achieve national accreditation before the end of 2019.
  - a.3 Apply for international accreditation by 2020.

**6. *Attract, recruit, and retain highly qualified faculty and staff at the College of Dentistry, and provide opportunities for professional development.***

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Foster academic environment to be conducive for professional development and educational opportunities.
  - a.1 Develop employee performance indicators.
  - a.2 Develop award programs for faculty, academic professionals, and College of Dentistry staff in recognition of their contributions to the College of Dentistry.
  - a.3 Create scheme for student exchange and short visits by distinguished academics.
  - a.4 Encourage distinguished staff to apply for part-time degrees.
  - a.5 Establish visiting professor program.
- b. Recruit and retain excellent faculty members and staff to support the College educational mission.
  - b.1 Pursue market analysis to determine competitive salary rates for faculty and staff and request funding for market adjustment, when needed.
  - b.2 Formulate and establish robust faculty and staff development program, including a mentoring system for new faculty.
  - b.3 Exit interview should be routinely conducted to explore the opportunities to improve retention of competent faculty and College of Dentistry staff.
  - b.4 Review faculty and employee satisfaction surveys.
- c. Provide supportive and welcoming learning and cultural environment to enhance the feeling of belongingness to the institution.
  - c.1 Conduct social committee to organize sport events and extracurricular social activities.
  - c.2 Conduct multi-cultural events.
  - c.3 Create social media page for the faculty and students to exchange opinions, share views, advertise social, and scientific activities.
  - c.4 Improve the annual orientation of new faculty members to include social sport activities.
  - c.5 Create social and cultural events during the academic year.

**7. Consolidate the integration of Dental Services-KAMC, College of Dentistry-KSAU-HS, and KAIMRC to reach the status of a unified oral health care system.**

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Maximize administrative efficiency between Dental Services-KAMC and College of Dentistry-KSAU-HS.
  - a.1 Create a Task Force from Dental Services-KAMC and College of Dentistry-KSAU-HS who will be responsible for development of action plan for consolidation of the two entities.
  - a.2 Create a joint Executive Board for Dental Services-KAMC and College of Dentistry-KSAU-HS, which will be responsible for the integration of clinical services, resources, and other operational services for the patients of both KAMC and College of Dentistry.
  - a.3 Utilize relevant manpower and resources of Dental Services-KAMC, College of Dentistry-KSAU-HS, and KAIMRC in accordance to the policies of the institution in terms of teaching, research, and patient care.

**8. Develop and maintain additional sustainable financial resources for College of Dentistry.**

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Maximize utilization of resources and achieve operational excellence.
  - a.1 Establish Business Development Unit in College of Dentistry to generate through utilization of College of Dentistry resources.
  - a.2 Explore alternative funding streams like investments, alumni, philanthropic organizations, etc.
  - a.3 Expand on postgraduate education and advanced education through collaboration with other organizations.
  - a.4 Implement processes that would decrease waste and avoid additional costs through administrative efficiencies and share services.

**9. *Improve the administrative efficiency of the College and its related Department's .***

This goal is achieved by the following projects, underneath are the initiatives to support each projects:

- a. Improve the workflow in the College to achieve operational excellence.
  - a.1 Evaluate and reorganize staff responsibilities based on the approved job description to efficiently address the College's needs.
  - a.2 Create and implement plans to provide guidelines and standards for departments to follow i.e. IPP, in accordance to the APP of the University.
  - a.3 Design administrative flowcharts per departments and units.
  - a.4 Evaluate and redesign administrative, compliance and approval processes, in alignment to the University policies and procedures.
  - a.5 Enhance communication using various means between the leaders, staff, and students.
  - a.6 Increase the paperless workflow within the College.
